What we are learning in class this week:

Bible – Isaac and Jacob. **Memory Verse due Wednesday 10/11** Genesis 22:17a “I will surely bless you and make your descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as the sand on the seashore.”

Reading/Language Arts – phonemes ir, ur, and ear; blending sounds to make 3- to 6-letter words; basic high-frequency words; sequence, main idea, and details; spelling with ay and ai; writing a sentence with details; planning and writing a paragraph

Math – doubles facts to 18 (should be memorized); understanding morning, afternoon, evening, and night; showing place value with drawings; adding 1 to a number (+1 facts); sorting to make a graph

Social Studies – compass rose, maps, and globes

*Reminders: Please purchase a set of addition flash cards and review when possible. Students need to memorize doubles facts to 18 (0+0 through 9+9) and +1 facts (0+1 through 9+1).
